



## KENNETH GALBRAITH FELLOWSHIP 2010

El Instituto Universitario de Investigación en Estudios Norteamericanos “Benjamin Franklin” de la Universidad de Alcalá offers the fellowship Kenneth Galbraith to tackle Economic Studies related to the United States.

- ✓ Nature: Research projects shall tackle Economic Studies related to the United States
- ✓ Candidates: researchers pre- post doctorate graduates.
- ✓ Duration: Scholarships may last 15 days in July or September.
- ✓ Scope: The Instituto Franklin will fund the scholarship with the amount of 1.600€ for researching. It consists of 600€ for accommodation expenses, 200€ for transportation, 100€ for photocopies and office material, 100€ for computer support and 600€ for books from the specific bibliography suggested by the applicant. These books will be part of the Instituto Franklin’s book collection but they will be offered to the applicant during the scholarship. There will also be provided a comfortable place for researching inside the Instituto headquarters.
- ✓ Eligibility criteria: A Commission designated by the Director of the Instituto Franklin will study the proposals and evaluate them; the final decision will be published on this website the first week of June.
- ✓ Application form. The call for 2010 applications is open until March, 16<sup>th</sup> 2010. The application form shall be submitted together with the following documents:
  - Curriculum Vitae
  - Letter of recommendation
  - Transcript of Assessment Results for students
  - Signed document stating that the applicant does not receive any other financial aid during the same period
  - Statement of purpose describing the objectives, importance and methodology of the project, together with a list of the needed bibliography for it.
